

TRANSFER STATION LABORER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

The work involves responsibility of general laboring, to ensure compliance with regulations and guidelines of a Solid Waste Transfer Station. The incumbent will work directly with the public, be required to operate heavy equipment, and be responsible for following the safety protocols and procedures of the Transfer Station. The work is performed under the supervision of the Transfer Station Working Manager. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only – Not a complete list)

- Performs a variety of manual labor tasks
- Equipment operation, i.e. loader operation
- Shovels snow and spreads salt
- Interfaces with the public and must always act professionally
- Understands and enforces Transfer Station rules and procedures
- Lifting recyclables/bags or other items into a container
- Works at different stations including the compactor, county recycling, and electronics recycling.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- None is required.
- Experience in manual labor is desired.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have a valid driver's license and reliable transportation
- Proficient in oral and written English
- Ability to understand and follow both oral and written instructions
- Tact and courtesy
- Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position
- Willingness to work in all weather conditions
- Ability to solicit the cooperation of the public
- This is a varied schedule position. The Transfer Station is open Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri, Sat from 7:30am-3:45pm.
