ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW 8 OF 2021, OPTING OUT OF PERMITTING CANNABIS RETAIL DISPENSARIES AND ON-SITE CONSUMPTION SITES IN THE TOWN OF MOREAU AS AUTHORIZED UNDER CANNABIS LAW ARTICLE 4 SECTION 1

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, by the Town Board of the Town of Moreau, that a public hearing was held on December 22, 2021, after which the Town Board adopted Local Law No. 8 of 2021 which added a local law to opt out of allowing cannabis retail dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption sites in the Town of Moreau that would otherwise be allowed under the Marihuana Regulation and Taxation Act, an abstract of which follows, which Local Law was adopted subject to a permissive referendum in accordance with Cannabis Law §131 and the procedure outlined in Municipal Home Rule Law §24.

Abstract: The purpose of this Local Law is to promote the public health, safety and welfare by opting out of the New York State cannabis legalization legislation in regard to retail sales and in regard to establishments for on-site consumption until such time as regulations and guidance from the state government has been promulgated and reviewed.

A petition, to be valid, must be submitted within 45 days of the date of adoption of this Local Law.
