The Town of Moreau now accepts certain electronics for recycling. The following items are allowed.

COMPUTERS:

All-in-one
Desktop
E-reader
Interactive flat panel display (w/ processor)
Laptop
Mini or Notebook
Smart display
Tablet
Thin client
Virtual reality headset (w/ processor)
Workstation

COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:

3-D printer (for computer, weighing <100 lbs.)
Digital picture frame (>4" diagonally)
Document scanner (for computer, <100 lbs.)
Electronic keyboard or keypad
Electronic mouse or similar pointing device
External hard drive
Facsimile (fax) machine
Label printer (for computer, weighing <100 lbs.)
Computer monitor
Computer printer (<100 lbs.)

SMALL ELECTRONICS

Cable or satellite receiver
Digital converter box
Digital video disc (DVD) player
Digital video recorder (DVR)
Electronic or video game console
Portable digital music player (w/ memory)
Projector w/ DVD player capability
Videocassette recorder (VCR)

SMALL COMPUTER SERVER

Designed in a desktop or similar form factor and capable of supporting only a single processor

OTHER TYPES OF RECYCLING

Loose paper, newspaper, magazines, soft cover books, shredded paper in clear bags, flattened cardboard boxes, empty clean cans & bottles, empty pizza boxes, and plastic with the "recycle" symbol can all be recycled in one bin.

We also accept:

- Auto batteries
- Empty propane tanks
- Large appliances - place in the open-top recycling container. Appliances containing Freon should be placed in a separate designated area. Saratoga County removes the Freon before recycling.
- 2-cycle fuels, and liquid household waste - add to cat litter or sawdust and evaporate a few days. Once dry, we will accept it.
- Paint - cannot be accepted in liquid form. Allow to dry or mix with litter or sawdust to speed drying before recycling.

Wrapping paper is not recyclable.
Please dispose of with household waste.

Cat litter can be mixed with household trash. If bagged separately, the rate is the same as the household trash rate according to the bag size.

Medical Waste, Including Sharps

Pesticides

Construction debris & demolition materials, including:

- Sheet Rock
- Hazardous Material
- Fiberglass Insulation
- Roofing Shingles
- Liquids, Including Paint
- Cement Blocks, Bricks, or Similar Materials

YARD WASTE

ACCEPTED FROM TOWN OF MOREAU RESIDENTS ONLY

Composting, leaves and grass clippings (MUST BE REMOVED FROM BAGS)

NO CHARGE

Brush & fallen limbs from storm damage (Maximum size: 4' long and 4" in diameter)

Passenger vehicles, pick-up trucks & small utility trailers not exceeding 6'x12'

NO CHARGE

Utility trailers larger than 6'x12', dump trailers, stake body and dump trucks

\$30.00 PER LOAD*

NO LOT CLEARING & NO COMMERCIAL HAULERS

*Exception: No Charge for Town of Moreau Mobile Home Park owners hauling on behalf of park residents.

Wood chips, when available, are free of charge for resident personal use. **Staff is unable to assist with loading due to safety concerns.**
