New Traffic Patterns on Northway Exit 17 Off-Ramps in Moreau, Saratoga County

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is advising motorists that beginning Monday, April 4, the off-ramps for Exit 17 of the Adirondack Northway (Interstate 87) will be reconfigured to utilize two, newly constructed T-shaped intersections at U.S. Route 9 in the Town of Moreau, Saratoga County. The intersections were constructed as part of a previously announced bridge replacement project.

As work on the project progresses, motorists should also continue to watch for lane and shoulder closures on the Northway and Route 9; as well as brief overnight closures of the Northway that are tentatively scheduled for the week of April 18 to remove existing overhead signs.

Motorists are urged to slow down and drive responsibly in work zones. Fines are doubled for speeding in a work zone. Convictions of two or more speeding violations in a work zone could result in the suspension of an individual's driver license.

Motorists are reminded to Move Over a lane, if safely possible, or slow down significantly whenever encountering roadside vehicles displaying red, white, blue, amber or green lights, including maintenance and construction vehicles in work zones.
