Summary Proceedings to evict and recover property and Small Claims Actions, which need to be scheduled in advance, begin on Wednesday afternoons at 2:00 p.m. immediately after Vehicle and Traffic Arraignments.

Criminal Court is at 9:00 a.m. every Wednesday

The Moreau Town Court is part of the Unified Court System of the State of New York and has jurisdiction over Criminal cases that occur in the Town of Moreau, violations of the Village of South Glens Falls and Town of Moreau Ordinances, vehicle and traffic offenses that occur in the Town of Moreau, Evictions and Small Claims actions involving up to \$3000.00.

Court Clerks perform administrative and clerical work in Maintaining Court Records. Court Clerks are there to be as helpful as possible but cannot give legal advice and have no authority to reduce or dismiss charges or alter fines set by the Judges.

Meeting with the Judge

Within the limits of Standards of Judicial Conduct, neither Judge is allowed to give any legal advice to anyone about any active case(s) in the United States, including cases active in the Moreau Town Court.

Prosecutor

The Office of the District Attorney of Saratoga County prosecutes all criminal cases and vehicle and traffic cases, within the County of Saratoga. The ADA (Assistant District Attorney) is only in Moreau Court while the Court is in session on Wednesday mornings. You may contact the Court for the procedure to follow for handling your vehicle and traffic tickets by mail. All criminal cases, including traffic misdemeanors, require a personal appearance by the Defendant.
